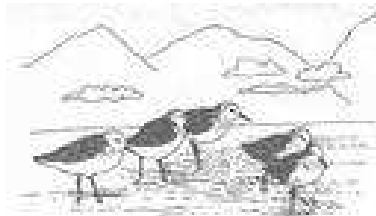
STATION #12
